

COLD SEASON CROPS to plant early

COOL SEASON LETTUCE-plant in Jan, Feb or March

-start seeds in small pots **inside**, under lights, NO heat mats

-transplant later outside under row cover, in cold frame, in hoop house, or greenhouse

VARIETY

Black seeded Simpson-plant early spring
Salad Bowl-red or green-plant early spring
Speckled Troutback-plant early spring
Santoro butterhead-plant early spring
Salonva-red or green-plant early spring
Yugoslavia Red-plant early spring
Marvel of Four Seasons-plant early spring
Merlot-plant early spring

DAYS TO HARVEST

days to harvest-21-40
days to harvest-28-40
days to harvest-28-50
days to harvest-30-60
days to harvest-30-55
days to harvest-30-55
days to harvest-50-60
days to harvest-45-55

SPINACH-plant in Jan, Feb or March

-start seeds in small pots inside, under lights, no heat mats

-transplant outside under row cover, in cold frame, in hoop house, or greenhouse

VARIETY

Carmel-plant early spring
Escalade-plant early spring

DAYS TO HARVEST

days to harvest-25-40
days to harvest-43-50

ARUGULA--plant in Jan, Feb or March

-start seeds in small pots inside, under lights, no heat mats

-transplant outside under row cover, in cold frame, in hoop house, or greenhouse

VARIETY

Rocket-plant early spring
Tuscan-plant early spring

DAYS TO HARVEST

days to harvest-30-45
days to harvest-30

WARM SEASON LETTUCE-plant seeds in mid-May or early June-can direct seed outside grow under shade or cover with row cover to provide shade in summer

VARIETY

Teague-plant early summer
Salanova-Batavia-green or red-plant early summer
Cardinale-plant early summer
Jester-plant early summer

DAYS TO HARVEST

days to harvest-30-70
days to harvest-35-55
days to harvest-48-60
days to harvest-60

These are just a few summer lettuces you can plant here in Santa Fe.
